

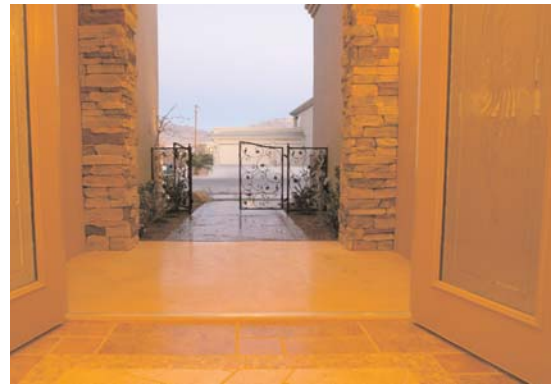

Zero-step threshold makes it convenient for moving and easy for visitors with strollers, or who use wheelchairs or walkers to enter the home.



32" interior passage into a bathroom that provides at least 30" by 48" space, making it accessible to ALL visitors.



The 30" by 48" space (that can overlap) provides functionality and spaciousness.



Level and firm entrance that welcomes ALL visitors!



Bedroom and bathroom that any visitor would enjoy!
